REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS, STEUBEN COUNTY REMC March 27, 2023

- 2. <u>Roll Call</u>. Roll call was taken by Secretary/Treasurer, **Gary Shough**, and all Board Members were present. Also present were **CEO Kevin Keiser and Attorney James A. McEntarfer.**
- 3. <u>General Consent Items.</u> The following items were reviewed and approved:
 - a. <u>Agenda</u>. The agenda for the meeting was approved.
 - b. <u>Minutes of February 27, 2023 Board Meeting</u>. The minutes for the February 27, 2023, Board Meeting were approved.
 - c. Bills. The bills for the past month were approved.
 - d. <u>Director Expenses</u>. Director expenses were approved.
 - e. New Hookups. New hookups were approved.
 - f. New Memberships. New memberships were approved.
 - g. IUPPS Update. The IUPPS update was reviewed.

- h. <u>Broadband Update/I-Man/Conexon Study.</u> **CEO Kevin Keiser** presented the Broadband progress report, an update regarding staff recommendations concerning sign-up/install fees presently being waived, and the fiber financial report. Discussion was then held and progress will continue through completing the project as scheduled.
- i. Annual Meeting Committee Report. Chairman Wayne Gingerich, Neasa Kalme, Bill Snyder, Members of the Annual Standing Committee Meeting, and Gary Shough presented their report and recommendations regarding the 2023 annual meeting. The recommendations were for a virtual format on Saturday, June 10, 2023, and a proposed member appreciation day on Tuesday, July 25, 2023 in connection with the 4-H County Fair.
- j. NRECA Annual Meeting (Power Xchange). Board Members Marc Nelson, Gary Shough, Mike Kurtz, Bill Snyder, Larry Jack, and Scott Charters presented reports on their attendance.
- 5. <u>Decisions Needed</u>. The following actions were taken or authorized upon unanimous vote of the Board:
 - A. <u>Safety Manual Review</u>. **CEO Kevin Keiser** presented information on the upcoming safety manual review process. It was decided to have corporate counsel, James A. McEntarfer, at least initially participate in the process and then to review the report.
 - B. <u>Pole Attachment Rate</u>. **CEO Kevin Keiser** presented information regarding the calculation, by statute, of the pole attachment rate. The Board then unanimously approved the 2023 rate of \$10.82.
