














Percent Line Loss


Average Residential Kwh Consumption



BOARD OF DIRECTORS MINUTES STEUBEN COUNTY REMC OPERATION ROUND-UP TRUST Steuben County REMC Office Angola, Indiana Quarter 2

July 12, 2023

I. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by President Craig Ralston.

The previous meeting minutes were approved and seconded by Smith and Reed.

IV. FINANCIALS:

The treasurer's report was read by Smith, indicating after paying out the previously approved grants and replenishing the \$2,500 fund held at the REMC for discretionary or emergency disbursements, a total of \$57,579.39 is being held by the SCCF.

V. GRANT APPLICATIONS:

The board reviewed the following grant requests. There were 3 requests totaling \$14,000. The following grant requests and amounts were then decided upon by the board as follows:

- 1) Hoosiers Feeding The Hungry (Requested \$3,000.00)
- "Meat" the Need Full Amount

The Board discussed what this organization is and Holden told about her experience donating in the past. Ferrell provided insight on the donated meat going to local food banks. The full amount was motioned by Smith and seconded by Reed. The requested information includes: what their process is to make sure the meat stays local and how much meat is donated each year.

- 2) Boomerang Backpacks (Requested \$8,000.00)
- 2023-2024 School Year Full Amount

The topic of discussion was the statistics that Boomerang Backpacks provided in their application on the overwhelming need in our community for children without food. The full amount was motioned by Ralston and seconded by Reed. No additional information was requested.

3) Land of Lakes Family Health Services (Requested \$3,000.00)

Medical Referral and Financial Medical Assistance Program Full Amount

There was some confusion about which organization this is. Ferrell explained that it is better known as the Wellness Clinic. The discussion revolved around how families, especially children are getting there, if the Clinic is meeting those in need at schools ex. Ferrell talked about the struggles that the Wellness Clinic has had and how they are improving how they are working with the other clinics in the area. Holden motioned for the full amount and Smith seconded the motion. The requested information includes: if they go to the schools and work with the counselors to know those who are in need.

Total Grant Requests Approved \$14,000.00

No other entities were considered for grants at this time.

The Steuben County Community Foundation will prepare the approved funds for approval of the Steuben County Community Foundation board, and prepare checks for dispersal and Britt Holden will prepare and distribute letters to the organizations informing them of the final decision with the Grant Agreement form. When the grant recipients return the Agreement they will receive the funds. They will then be made aware of any conditions involved with the grant and the need to fill out and submit the Final Project Report Form upon completion of their project.

VI. NEW BUSINESS:

The Board appointed Cheryl Reed as Vice President and took a Board photo.

VII. ADJOURNMENT:

The application deadlines for the 2023 year are September 29, and December 29. The correlating tentative board meetings are October 11, and January 10.

The next deadline for submitting applications will be Friday, September 29 for the third quarter of the 2023 funding cycle, which will also be publicized in the same outlets, as well as on the REMC website.

The next Board meeting will take place Wednesday, October 11 at 9:00 AM at the REMC office. At the next meeting the board will review the grant applications received prior to the September 29, 2023 deadline and decide upon quarterly disbursements.

With nothing further to discuss, the meeting was adjourned.




SUBSCRIBER ADOPTION RATE



SUBSCRIBERS BY TIER






